Zimrelief has been providing a sterling education service in Zimbabwe and many children are able to go to school each year because of your involvement! Please keep up the good work. Education of the country has seen many changes being introduced to adapt the new curriculum which came to stay. In primary schools from ECD to grade 7, teachers are teaching many subjects to prepare them to undertake the core learning areas of the Secondary Schools syllabuses which has 7 core subjects plus several elective learning areas.

It has also emerged that Agriculture be among the core subjects children should learn to prepare them to hands on skills should they leave school. Although, it has theory component in its syllabus structure, children should have more practical training sessions and many schools have a garden for the practical session. It is indeed positively working.

Glen Forest has students who also benefitted from fees coming from ZimRelief. Thanks to ZimRelief for this wonderful support. The fund has benefitted 8 study group children who are

coming at the Centre for their studies. A lot of attention is to be made next year as most children coming at Glen Forest studying primary have once been at school but have dropped due to lack of school fees. As they continue to come, they require 100% full support to motivate their coming to school as well provides adequate learning material.

Five students on Scholarships for examinations received \$75.00 each towards their examinations fees for the year 2017. These students if they pass very well are to proceed to form 5 next year. Thank God examinations for this year were conducted very well without experiencing some challenges of exam malpractice like last year. In 2016, 3 of the scholarship students who proceeded to form five from my school are doing very well at Parirewa High.
